



Mlilwane Wildlife Sanctuary

Escape to Nature - 15h00-18h00

Mlilwane is Swaziland's oldest protected area. Formerly a productive mixed farming operation, with extensive tin mining in the low foothills of the Nyonyane Mountains, the Sanctuary has been rehabilitated into a reserve where one can enjoy the beauty of the surroundings and the abundant wildlife that grace the plains.

For those with little time, this is a perfect way to escape to nature and enjoy a few hours of tranquility.



Collection from your hotel after lunch.

Upon arrival at the reserve's main camp, head off on a guided walk, where herds of game of the smaller kind will be encountered.



Upon return to the camp, depart on a sundowner open landrover gamedrive, winding up onto the striking Nyonyane Mountain with its exposed granite peak known as the "Rock of Execution".

Nyonyane is where ancient San once lived and where Swazi Royal graves are situated, giving historical significance.

Afternoon trips depart from the Ezulwini Valley area at 14h00, returning at approximately 18h00.
